ANNOUNCEMENT OF RAILWAY ENGINEERING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP AND INNOTRANS CAREER AWARD

REMSA Announces \$10,000 Railway Engineering Education Scholarship and InnoTrans Career Award

The Railway Engineering-Maintenance Suppliers Association (REMSA) is pleased to announce the availability of two awards, for students who have the intent to pursue a career in the railway engineering-maintenance industry.

One (1) **Railway Engineering Education Scholarship**, up to \$10,000 for junior or senior undergraduates, or students in graduate school, trade schools, or other continuing education programs, who are pursuing additional education to allow them to work successfully and grow within the rail construction and maintenance industry.

Additionally, REMSA is partnering with InnoTrans to send one student to attend InnoTrans 2024 in Berlin, Germany with the **InnoTrans Career Award**. The concept of the Career Award is to spark the interest of the future generation in rail and promote career opportunities within the rail industry. InnoTrans will provide the students with opportunities to meet directly with global players, small- and medium-sized companies, specialized associations, and universities and learn about their current job vacancies, traineeships/internship, job profiles and fields of work.

ABOUT InnoTrans

InnoTrans is the world's leading trade show for rail transportation technology and takes place every two years in Berlin. In 2022, 2,771 exhibitors from 56 countries presented their rail industry innovations to 137,404 trade visitors from 137 countries. Five segments of transportation are represented at InnoTrans, and include Railway Technology, Railway Infrastructure, Public Transport, Interiors and Tunnel Construction. InnoTrans also features Outdoor Displays on 3,500 meters of track, where everything from tank wagons to high-speed locomotives are on display.

AMOUNT OF AWARDS:

REMSA Railway Engineering Education Scholarship: Scholarship funds, awarded annually, are sent to the financial aid office at each recipient's institution to be applied to the student's account at the beginning of the spring term of study. Students must be in attendance for a full year following receipt of the award.

InnoTrans Career Award:

Each student award includes: Flight or train round trip ticket - economy class, Hotel accommodation in Berlin for max. four nights, VIP card for InnoTrans (four days), Free access to public transportation throughout Berlin during the show days, Access to the InnoTrans Campus which includes the RecruitingLAB, Talent Stage and Jobwall, Daily travel allowance, and guided career tours for students to exhibitors with career openings.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants may apply for either or both awards, based on the following eligibility criteria. Applicants may apply for both awards in the same application.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

A complete application and all accompanying materials must be submitted by November 28, 2023 for consideration. The absence of any of the materials listed below will render the application incomplete.

To apply for one or both awards, all materials listed below must be sent to the REMSA Scholarship Committee:

1. A completed Application, including a personal narrative, submitted online.
2. An official transcript from all undergraduate and graduate schools attended, and indicating all college-level work completed through September 1st of the year the application is made. The transcript(s) should list courses taken or in which currently enrolled.
3. Two letters of recommendation from education or industry mentors. It is your responsibility to obtain the references and request that they submit their letters directly to the Association and are received no later than November 28, 2023. Letters of recommendation may be submitted electronically via email to baker@remsa.org. Emails must come directly from reference.
4. A professional resume detailing work history and experience

APPLICATION DEADLINE — November 28, 2023

A complete application and all accompanying materials must be sent to the REMSA Scholarship Committee no later than November 28 for consideration. **The absence of any of the materials listed below will render the application incomplete. It is recommended that applicants contact the REMSA office (baker@remsa.org) in early November to inquire about the status of their application regarding receipt of the materials required for consideration.**

EVALUATION AND NOTIFICATION

A Scholarship Committee appointed by the REMSA Board of Directors will base its evaluation for awards on the materials submitted. All applicants will be informed of awards in December. **Recipients will be required to submit a final official transcript including grades for the fall term.**
