Over the past year there have been lots of questions surrounding the future of Railway Interchange. Since our last Railway Interchange event, held in the fall of 2023 in Indianapolis, there has been much confusion about what the event will look like in the future, and we'd like to try to add some clarity.

Railway Interchange began in 2011 with a directive from the Class I Railroads for the rail industry to create one trade show that covers all facets of the industry. As a result, the American Railway Engineering & Maintenance of Way Association (AREMA), Railway Engineering-Maintenance Suppliers Association (REMSA), Railway Supply Institute (RSI), and Railway Systems Suppliers, Inc. (RSSI) partnered to do just that, with the event taking place every-other year. Railway Interchange proved to be a successful model for the industry, bringing railroaders, suppliers, contractors, engineers, and everyone in between, together in one place and quickly became the largest railway exhibiting and educational conference in North America.


In the spring of 2022, AREMA made a financial decision to step away from the Railway Interchange partnership after the 2023 event and to host their own standalone conference. While this was an unexpected development for the other associations, REMSA, RSI, and RSSI are committed to the mission of bringing the rail industry together for one premier event. The Railway Interchange partners are open to working with AREMA and hopeful that AREMA will reconsider their decision for the future.

Moving forward and building on the extensive history of the event, Railway Interchange will continue to be hosted annually each year by REMSA, RSI, and RSSI. Railway Interchange is attended by over 5,000 rail industry professionals from around the globe and showcases the latest technology, product development, services, and research.


